BREAKFAST & BRUNCH



PASQUAL'S

LOCATION: ON THE PLAZA

Our favorite breakfast/brunch spot in town! Expect a 15–30 minute wait, but it's always worth it. Try the gluten-free seed & nut bread as a side or appetizer. We love getting an entire loaf (it's not cheap, but delicious), especially as a healthy snack for hiking.

THE PANTRY RIO

LOCATION: NEAR PLAZA ON GALISTEO

An easy and fun spot with minimal wait and a great patio. The “Chili Relleno Omelette” with green chili is incredible!

CLAFOUTIS

LOCATION: OFF CORDOVA ROAD

Wonderful French bakery, perfect for breakfast pastries or brunch. Kids love the baked goods at the take-out counter.

BREAKFAST & BRUNCH

REVOLUTION BAKERY

LOCATION: ORDER ONLINE (SELLS OUT QUICKLY!)

100% gluten-free bakery with amazing donuts and cinnamon rolls. Great option if you need to cater to dietary restrictions.

CAFE FINA

LOCATION: OLD LAS VEGAS HWY (CLOSE TO BOTH HOMES)

Casual counter-service spot ideal for breakfast, coffee, and baked goods. Quick and convenient with a kid-friendly patio and small playground.

BREAKFAST & BRUNCH

MODERN GENERAL FEED & SEED

LOCATION: CERRILLOS ROAD

Fantastic healthy brunch option with great juices, avocado toast, coffee, and gluten-free options. Don't miss their Acai Teffcakes.

HENRY & THE FISH

LOCATION: NEAR PLAZA ON SAN FRANCISCO

Casual café great for breakfast, smoothies, salads, sandwiches, and excellent coffee.

APOTHECARY

LOCATION: IN THE PLAZA

Unique breakfast and lunch spot featuring health-conscious food, an oxygen bar, and unique cacao coffee drinks. A great spot for a detox or nutritious start to your day.

CASUAL LUNCH



THE TEAHOUSE

LOCATION: CANYON ROAD

Our absolute favorite lunch spot in Santa Fe. Known for great teas, coffee, sandwiches, and salads. There's usually a short wait, so put your name down and browse the art galleries nearby while waiting.

COYOTE CAFE CANTINA (ROOFTOP)

LOCATION: NEAR THE PLAZA

Casual Mexican dining with rooftop views of downtown. This spot is lively (the music is energetic!) and the quesadillas are kid-approved.

CASUAL LUNCH

PLAZA CAFE DOWNTOWN

LOCATION: ON THE PLAZA

Casual spot serving breakfast all day, plus lunch and dinner. The food is simple but reliable, and the location makes for a great experience.

EL PARASOL

LOCATIONS: MULTIPLE LOCATIONS (CERRILLOS ROAD, PLUS OTHERS AROUND TOWN)

Hands down, the best tacos in Santa Fe—possibly in the world! Primarily a pickup spot with limited seating at some locations. We typically grab tacos to enjoy at El Rey Court's courtyard (near the Cerrillos location), the Aspen Vista Picnic Site, or back at the house. Try the chicken tacos or shredded beef—and be warned, their salsa packs some serious heat!

CAFE FINA

LOCATION: OLD LAS VEGAS HWY (CLOSE TO BOTH HOMES)

Casual counter-service spot ideal for breakfast or lunch, coffee, and baked goods. Features a kid-friendly patio and playground.

IZANAMI – TEN THOUSAND WAVES

LOCATION: ON THE ROAD TO SKI BASIN

Japanese cuisine and sushi in a beautiful mountain setting. Great for lunch after hiking nearby trails.

DINNER SPOTS

Important Note: *Santa Fe is very much a “reservation town” and restaurants often book quickly. We strongly recommend making reservations several weeks in advance, especially for dinner, to ensure you secure your desired dates and times.*

THE SHED

LOCATION: ON THE PLAZA

Hands-down our favorite traditional New Mexican restaurant. Famous for enchiladas and margaritas. Reservations (by phone) are strongly recommended at least a week in advance. Try the chicken enchilada plate “Christmas-style” (warning: spicy!), green chili stew, and the gold coin margaritas.

PINK ADOBE

LOCATION: OLD SANTA FE TRAIL (NEAR SAN MIGUEL CHAPEL)

Our second-favorite spot for traditional New Mexican cuisine with a charming patio and cozy indoor fireplaces. Easier to book than The Shed—reservations still recommended. Favorites include Clams Lucifer, Plato Mexicano, seafood enchiladas, and Pink Dragon margaritas.



DINNER SPOTS

HARRY'S ROAD HOUSE

LOCATION: OLD LAS VEGAS HWY (VERY CLOSE TO THE HOUSES)

A beloved local favorite featuring American comfort food and Southwest-inspired dishes. Casual atmosphere with eclectic, rotating menu items ranging from enchiladas to pizzas. Great pies—try lemon meringue or coconut cream. Request seating on the back patio.

EL FAROL

LOCATION: CANYON ROAD

Historic Spanish tapas and New Mexican cuisine spot housed in a 100-year-old building. They often feature live music and a weekly flamenco dance show (tickets required in advance). Enjoy great tapas, Spanish wines, and margaritas.

UPPER CRUST PIZZA

LOCATIONS: NEAR THE PLAZA, PLUS A CONVENIENT EL DORADO LOCATION CLOSE TO THE HOUSES

Casual spot serving amazing pizzas (including great gluten-free options) and hearty salads. Easy to order at the counter, grab a seat on the patio, or take pizza back home.

DINNER SPOTS

TESUQUE VILLAGE

LOCATION: TESUQUE (NORTH OF TOWN)

Casual and family-friendly spot serving sandwiches, burgers, pizza, and more. A relaxed, local vibe.

IL NIDO

LOCATION: TESUQUE (NORTH OF TOWN)

Creative American cuisine with wood-fired dishes including pizzas, chicken, and steaks. Upscale atmosphere with a great ambiance.

Our absolute favorite upscale restaurant in Santa Fe, offering elevated New Mexican cuisine. Incredible food and sophisticated atmosphere—perfect for date night (not kid-friendly). Be sure to try the “Sopa De Amor” and their signature dessert, “Dulce Sinfonia.” Reservations fill quickly, so book months in advance.



GERONIMO

LOCATION: CANYON ROAD

Renowned contemporary American cuisine with excellent food and upscale ambiance. Arrive early and enjoy a drink at their charming bar before your meal. They also offer a less formal bar menu. Reservations strongly recommended.

SKYFIRE – BISHOP'S LODGE RESORT

LOCATION: BISHOP'S LODGE ROAD

Stunning views and beautiful outdoor areas. Ideal for dinner or our favorite happy hour, featuring excellent chips, guac, and queso. The property has a large open field that's great for kids to play.

UPSCALE / DATE NIGHT DINING

TERRA – FOUR SEASONS RESORT

LOCATION: FOUR SEASONS RESORT, SANTA FE

An elegant setting with a beautiful patio, perfect for dinner or sunset drinks. Heaters are available for cooler evenings. Even if dining elsewhere, stop by afterward for dessert and s'mores around their picturesque firepit. Reservations recommended.

IZANAMI – TEN THOUSAND WAVES

LOCATION: ON THE ROAD TO SKI BASIN

Sophisticated Japanese cuisine and sushi located in a beautiful mountain setting. Ideal for lunch or dinner, especially after mountain hikes. Our favorites include Chirashizushi, Bento Box, and their famous fried chicken (“tori no karaage”).

THE COMPOUND

LOCATION: CANYON ROAD

Upscale contemporary American cuisine offering a refined dining experience. Reservations recommended, especially if visiting during peak seasons or weekends.

Lupe Location (Guadalupe St.) — Excellent coffee, sandwiches, tacos, and a charming patio.

Downtown Location (Galisteo St.) — Located inside a cozy bookstore, just steps from the Plaza.

Serves La Colombe coffee (a personal favorite). Offers a wide variety of creative drinks like matcha lattes, lavender lattes, smoothies, and more.

Fantastic selection of teas and coffee beverages. A perfect spot to relax after exploring galleries along Canyon Road.

Sister restaurant to The Shed, serving similarly fantastic New Mexican food with a casual, inviting atmosphere.

OSTERIA D'ASSISI

LOCATION: DOWNTOWN SANTA FE

Charming Italian restaurant tucked just off the Plaza, serving housemade pastas, seafood, and classic northern Italian dishes with warm, old-world service. A great change of pace from New Mexican fare.

LA CASA SENA

LOCATION: NEAR THE PLAZA

Mediterranean-inspired cuisine known for a wonderful outdoor patio. Great spot for happy hour margaritas and chips with guacamole on a nice day. Inside, servers often perform live show tunes, creating a unique atmosphere.

PALOMA

LOCATION: NEAR THE RAILYARD

Upmarket Mexican cuisine featuring exceptional craft cocktails in a vibrant setting.

BOBCAT BITE

We take our kids every time, often after a beautiful hike in the nearby mountains, and follow up with lunch at their fantastic onsite restaurant, Izanami. It's a magical, relaxing, and memorable experience that we can't recommend enough. Be sure to reserve your private hot tub session well in advance, as they book quickly.

EXPLORA SCIENCE CENTER (ALBUQUERQUE)

Located about 50 minutes away in Albuquerque, Explora is an interactive science museum perfect for curious kids of all ages. Combine your visit with lunch at Saw Mill Market, a nearby food hall offering diverse dining options.





SANDIA PEAK TRAMWAY (ALBUQUERQUE)

Enjoy stunning panoramic views from this breathtaking aerial tram ride to the top of Sandia Peak in Albuquerque. It's an exciting adventure kids and adults will equally enjoy. Consider reservations if dining at the mountaintop restaurant.

NEW MEXICO MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY (ALBUQUERQUE)

Fascinating interactive exhibits and displays—an enjoyable educational outing for the whole family. Easily combined with a visit to Explora.

SPAS & WELLNESS

TEN THOUSAND WAVES

Iconic, Japanese-inspired spa located in a beautiful mountain setting. Offers a variety of luxurious spa treatments, massages, and private hot tubs with their own sauna and cold plunge. Our absolute favorite way to unwind after hiking.

FOUR SEASONS SPA

Set within the stunning Four Seasons Resort, this luxurious spa offers exceptional treatments and wellness experiences in a serene and beautiful atmosphere.

OJO SANTA FE SPA RESORT

Enjoy lush, tranquil surroundings at Ojo Santa Fe, known for its natural thermal soaking pools, restorative spa treatments, and relaxing atmosphere.



OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES & HIKING TRAILS

OUR FAVORITE HIKES

ALAMO VISTA TRAIL

Our absolute favorite hike in Santa Fe—challenging and pretty steep, but rewarding. It peaks at the top of the ski basin with amazing panoramic views. It is especially gorgeous in the fall when the aspens change color.

TSANKAWI

Our favorite easy hike and exploring spot. You'll discover fascinating old Native American caves along this short trail, offering spectacular views from the side of a plateau. (Note: involves climbing several steep ladders.)

GHOST RANCH (CHIMNEY ROCK TRAIL)

About a 1.5-hour scenic drive north of Santa Fe, Ghost Ranch offers incredible views and excellent hikes. We particularly love the Chimney Rock hike, which has breathtaking vistas and unique landscapes. Horseback riding is also available here, along with good lunch or snack options nearby at Fire and Ice or Café Abiquiu & LaTerraza.

SUN MOUNTAIN TRAIL

Very close to the house, just a quick drive down Old Santa Fe Trail. It's a short (but challenging), scenic hike with good elevation and beautiful views.

NINE MILE ROAD "RAIL TRAIL"

A flat, scenic stretch of the Santa Fe Rail Trail just minutes from the houses—ideal for an easy walk, run, or bike ride with wide-open high-desert views.

ASPEN VISTA PICNIC SITE

A beautiful spot near the ski mountain, perfect for lunch and picnicking. They have picnic tables, restrooms, and a gentle scenic trail ideal for all levels.

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES & HIKING TRAILS

NAMBE FALLS

Great summer hiking experience approximately 35 minutes north of Santa Fe. This unique hike involves walking partially through shallow water and mini rapids, ending at stunning waterfalls where you can swim or climb. Bring cash to pay the entrance fee.

OTHER GREAT HIKES

BANDELIER NATIONAL MONUMENT

Explore historic cave dwellings and cliff houses at Bandelier. Arrive early to avoid crowds, as it's a popular site with fascinating history and well-maintained trails.

HYDE PARK WATERFALL TRAIL

Great short and easy hike perfect for families and kids. It leads to a charming small waterfall, making for a quick outdoor adventure.

DALE BALL TRAILS

An extensive network of interconnected trails close to downtown Santa Fe, suitable for a variety of skill levels. These trails offer beautiful scenery and are popular for hiking, running, and mountain biking.

WINSOR PEAK

Located at the Santa Fe Ski Basin, Winsor Peak trail is challenging and rewarding, offering scenic alpine vistas and wildflowers. It's particularly beautiful in summer and early fall.

BORREGO / BEAR WALLOWS

A moderate loop trail that leads through lush forested areas and along a gentle creek. This hike is especially beautiful in autumn when the foliage colors become vibrant.



OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES & HIKING TRAILS

SKIING, SLEDDING & WINTER SPORTS

SKI SANTA FE

Just a short drive from town, Ski Santa Fe offers fantastic skiing and snowboarding with diverse terrain suited to all skill levels. It's a great mountain with family-friendly amenities, lessons, and rentals available.

TAOS SKI VALLEY

Approximately a 1.5-hour drive north, Taos Ski Valley offers legendary skiing and snowboarding, known for its challenging runs, beautiful alpine scenery, and vibrant ski-town atmosphere. Ideal for more advanced skiers looking for exceptional terrain and snow conditions.

SLEDDING AT HYDE MEMORIAL STATE PARK

Located just 15 minutes from downtown Santa Fe, Hyde Memorial State Park transforms into a winter wonderland, offering designated sledding hills when conditions permit. The park features multiple sledding areas, including a popular lower hill that opens with fresh snowfall. It's a favorite spot for families and kids to enjoy the snow. Remember to bring your own sleds or tubes, as rentals are not available on-site. A small day-use fee per vehicle (around \$5) applies.

UNIQUE OUTDOOR EXPERIENCES

SKY RAILWAY

Enjoy a newly restored historic train ride running between Santa Fe and Lamy, NM. Choose from themed rides like murder mysteries, folklore, or music events. A memorable and unique experience suitable for all ages. Be sure to book tickets in advance.

WHITE WATER RAFTING (SANTA FE RAFTING COMPANY)

Our favorite rafting outfitter offers a variety of river adventures:

- **The Taos Box:** Thrilling higher-level rafting for adventurous adults.
- **The Orilla Verde:** Calm and gentle, ideal for families with small children.
- **The Race Course:** Easy and fun, suitable for beginners and families.

HOT AIR BALLOONING

Take a sunrise balloon flight over the high desert for unforgettable views of the Rio Grande Valley and the Sangre de Cristo mountains. Albuquerque—about an hour away—is the ballooning capital of the world, with several outfitters offering daily flights, weather permitting. Book in advance.

FLY FISHING ON THE PECOS RIVER

Just 30 minutes outside Santa Fe, the Pecos River provides excellent fly-fishing opportunities in a tranquil setting. Whether you're an experienced angler or a first-timer, enjoy a peaceful day fishing in one of Northern New Mexico's scenic waterways.

PUYE CLIFFS

Take a guided tour of historic Native American cliff dwellings at Puye Cliffs, located near Española. Learn about fascinating local history and enjoy the beautiful landscapes. This is a slower-paced but rewarding cultural experience.

DAY TRIPS WORTH THE DRIVE

RANCHO DE CHIMAYO

LOCATION: CHIMAYO, NM

About a 35-minute scenic drive from Santa Fe, Rancho de Chimayo offers an authentic New Mexican dining experience in a beautiful setting. We love visiting for lunch, enjoying their delicious food, and sipping prickly pear margaritas on the outdoor patio or in the sunroom. Don't miss the historic chapel located right next door.

EL PARAGUA

LOCATION: ESPAÑOLA, NM

Also about 35 minutes from Santa Fe, El Paragua is owned by the same family as El Parasol and offers incredible traditional New Mexican dishes and fantastic margaritas served by the pitcher. It may not look like much from the outside, but the food is among the best you'll ever taste.

GHOST RANCH

LOCATION: ABIQUIU, NM

About a 1.5-hour drive north, Ghost Ranch is renowned for its breathtaking landscapes and inspiring hikes like Chimney Rock. Beyond hiking, enjoy horseback riding or grab lunch at nearby Fire and Ice or Café Abiquiu & LaTerraza.

CAMPO AT LOS POBLANOS

LOCATION: ALBUQUERQUE, NM

Set on the historic Los Poblanos lavender farm in Albuquerque's Rio Grande Valley, about an hour from Santa Fe. Campo serves outstanding seasonal, field-to-fork cuisine in a beautifully restored dairy barn—worth pairing with a stroll through the lavender fields and the farm shop.

ALBUQUERQUE

Just under an hour's drive away, Albuquerque offers several family-friendly attractions. Our kids love visiting the New Mexico Museum of Natural History and Explora Science Center. Pair your visit with lunch at the nearby Saw Mill Market food hall. Don't miss the incredible Sandia Peak Tramway for stunning views from the mountaintop.
